Never heard of Mayaguana? Neither had we until a couple years ago. It's the easternmost island in the Bahamas and one of the few islands to retain its Lucayan name. Located northeast of the Turks & Caicos, it's one of the most isolated Bahamian islands. To the east are the deep waters of the Atlantic Ocean. We'll fly into Provo (Turks & Caicos Islands) and board the *Turks & Caicos Explorer II* for a week of diving some of the most unspoiled coral reefs in this part of the world.
